**ORDER**

This Order may be cited as the Order to declare the 2010 Forest Fire Season and is in effect in the following areas during the periods specified below:

- (a) between the hours of midnight on April 30, 2010, and midnight on September 30, 2010 on the Island portion of the province; and
- (b) between the hours of midnight on May 14, 2010, and midnight on September 30, 2010, on the Labrador portion of the province.

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**PERMIT TO BURN**

Notice is hereby given that under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 98 of The Forestry Act of the Revised Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador, 1990, and the Forest Fire Regulations, the public are advised that every person setting, between the hours of midnight on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010, and midnight of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, on the Island portion of the province and between the hours of midnight on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010, and midnight of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, on the Labrador portion of the province, a fire for the purpose of clearing land or burning brush, slash, etc. on forest land or within three hundred meters of forest land, shall first obtain a Permit to Burn from the Minister of Natural Resources, or from a person authorized by the Minister to issue such permits.

To obtain a Permit to Burn the public may apply at any Regional or District Forest Management Office of the Department of Natural Resources. A copy of the Forest Fire Regulations is also available at these offices.

A person or party who violates this provision is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to such penalty as specified in The Forestry Act.

The general public is warned that there is a forest fire hazard associated with Spring surface drying and extreme caution should be taken when burning or traveling on or near forest land.
