Description of the Agreement

- 1) This Agreement concerns Mineral Licence(s) 00000M, 00001M and 00002M located at Red Indian Lake, Central Newfoundland, NTS 12A/16.
- 2) The parties herein agree that the property will be held jointly with the following ownership percentages: John Doe 50%, John Smith 25% and Bill Doe 25%.
- 3) The parties also agree to a 10 km area of influence . If one or any of the parties herein named in this agreement stake claims within this area of influence, the claims will become part of this agreement. (*Optional*)
- 4) The parties further agree that John Doe will be solely responsible for attracting and dealing with potential options. (*Optional*)
