

QUARRY PERMIT RE-APPLICATIONS: Production Reporting, Forms & Fees

If you are re-applying for a Quarry Permit you held last year, your application will be considered incomplete and will not be processed unless the following are submitted:

- ✓ Re-Application form
- ✓ Production Report form
- ✓ Quarry Royalty (\$0.75 per cubic metre)
- ✓ Quarry Permit Rental Fee (Re-Application) (\$120 per hectare)
- ✓ Quarry Permit Re-Application fee (\$100)

The Production Report Form, along with the Royalty payment, must be submitted to this Department within two months of the termination or expiry of a quarry permit as per Section 5(2)(c) of the Quarry Materials Act, SNL 1998. **The Production Report Form MUST be filed even if there was no production.**

NOTE:

If a complete and acceptable re-application package is not received within 2 months of expiry of a quarry permit, the site will be available for application by other parties.
